Become an ONCAT External Reviewer!

If you have experience working in postsecondary student mobility, and/or lived experience as a transfer student, become an external reviewer. External Reviewers play an important role in helping to determine funding decisions at ONCAT.

To ensure that we have a broad representation of reviewers, we are seeking subject matter experts from colleges, universities and Indigenous Institutes, Francophone/bilingual institutions, transfer students and student-interest groups, postsecondary education sector organizations and researchers. We also convene an Indigenous review panel to assess Indigenous student mobility strategies, as well as a Francophone review panel to assess Francophone/bilingual student mobility strategies.

What can you expect?

- External reviewers assess approximately 4-8 proposals/year, with a potential conference call/in-person meeting to discuss proposals.
- You can also serve as an external reviewer even if you have applied for ONCAT funding.

Please note, not all applicants will be selected to review proposals in a given grant cycle. It can depend on the volume of proposals, and specific subject matter expertise needed.
